

# End User License Agreement (EULA) for VLeBooks

## INTRODUCTION

This End-User Licence Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity) and A.T. Little & Sons Limited T/A Browns Books (and referred to in this Agreement as "Browns Books") for the VLeBooks software application ("Software") and covers usage of the software application available for Windows and MacOS computers and in the Apple App Store and Google Play Store.

By installing, copying, or otherwise using the Software, you agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA. If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, do not install or use the Software.

## 1. Grant of Licence

Browns Books grants you (whether you are an individual or represent an institution) a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to install and use the Software on an unlimited number of devices.

- a) For Individuals: This licence is for your personal, non-commercial use.
- b) For Institutions: This licence is for use by your employees, students, or other authorised members. "Institutions" include, but are not limited to, educational establishments and businesses.
- c) Distribution by Institutions: Institutions are permitted to distribute the Software and any subsequent updates, at no cost, to their employees, students, or other authorised members for their use in accordance with this EULA.

This licence is non-transferable. You may not transfer this EULA or the rights granted herein to any third party, with the exception of the specific distribution rights granted to Institutions in section 1(c).

## 2. Restrictions On Use

You agree not to, and you will not permit others to:

- a) Reverse-engineer, decompile, disassemble, or otherwise attempt to discover the source code or underlying ideas or algorithms of the Software;
- b) Modify, adapt, translate, or create derivative works based on the Software;
- c) Sell, rent, lease, sublicense, assign, or otherwise transfer rights to the Software to any third party;
- d) Remove any proprietary notices, labels, or marks on the Software.

## 3. Ownership and Intellectual Property

You acknowledge that the Software is licensed, not sold, to you. Browns Books retains all copyright, title, and intellectual property rights in and to the Software, including any copies and derivative works. All rights not expressly granted to you in this EULA are reserved by Browns Books.

## 4. Data Privacy and Disclaimer of Warranty

Personal data is collected and processed when you use the Software. All such processing is subject to the VLeBooks Privacy Policy here. The software is provided "as is," with all faults and without warranty of any kind. Browns Books expressly disclaims all warranties, either express or implied, including, but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, and non-infringement. Browns Books does not warrant that the functions contained in the software will meet your requirements, or that the operation of the software will be uninterrupted or error-free.

## 5. Limitation of Liability

In no event shall Browns Books be liable for any special, incidental, indirect, or consequential damages whatsoever (including,

but not limited to, damages for loss of profits, data loss, system crashes, business interruption, or any other pecuniary loss) arising out of the use of or inability to use the software, even if Browns Books has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

## **6. Termination**

This EULA is effective until terminated. Your rights under this EULA will terminate automatically without notice from Browns Books if you fail to comply with any term(s) of this EULA. Upon termination, you shall cease all use of the Software and destroy all copies, full or partial, of the Software in your possession or control.

## **7. Governing Law**

This EULA shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales, without regard to its conflict of law provisions.
